The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pittsfield, Pike County, Illinois, was held on Tuesday, August 4, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the City Council room at 215 North Monroe Street. The purpose of the meeting was to transact any business legally brought before it. Alderman Scheiwe moved to approve the minutes of the last regular Council meeting.
